1. As per the Govt. resolution, Dept. of Education No. MIS-1074/1303-M, Date:27/June/1994, hereby the following reservation is ordained.

1. Schedule Cast and neo Buddhists(SC)	13%
2. Schedule Tribe(ST)	07%
3. Nomadic Tribe(NT)	04%
4. Other Backward Classes,(OBC)	10%

Total 34%

2. As per the Govt.resolution, Dept. Of General Administration No.BCC-1093/2167/CR-141/93/16(B), Date:23/March/1994 hereby 'Mandal Commission' recommended the following reservation for a different category.

1. Tribes (14 more of tribes)	03%
2. Nomadic Tribes (Tribes before 1990 and more of 28)	2.5%
3. Nomadic Tribes (Dhangar and more of, as listed)	3.5%
4. Nomadic Tribes (Vanjari and more of as listed)	02%
5. other Backward Class (OBC)	19%

Total 30%

3. There is a resolution for different categories such as differently-abled, defense service, NRIs, Candidates nominated by the Govt.of India. Regarding this, the Govt. has considered the above provision hence providing the reservation to the above-mentioned categories in Government/Private, Grantable/Non-grantable Arts/commerce/Science college in proportion.

1. Schedule caste (person embraces the Buddhism)	13%
2. Scheduled Tribes	07%
3. Tribes (14 more of)	03%
4. Nomadic Tribes (Tribes before 1990 and more of 28)	2.5%
5. Nomadic Tribes (Dhangar and more of, as listed)	3.5%

4. The said reservation will be in accordance with the college course and in proportion thereof.
5. Reserved seats to be filled in first even through the candidate has secured admission on reserve seats, his candidature should be considered on a merit basis by his merit for upgraded courses as per the college rules.
6. In case of non-availability of candidate reserved category, the seats cannot be carried forward next year, so then the seat to be filled and accommodated by the candidate of other categories, the same is to be administered as per the directive principle, schedule 2, dated 27/June/1974, While doing so, the concerned authority should make sure that the reservation hence executed should not exceed the limit of 50% in total.
7. According to the recommendation of the 'Mandal Commission'. The principle of 'Crèmes Layer' has been approved by the central government. Concerning this, the details of directives have been prescribed to the Dept. Social welfare, Cultural Work, Sport and Tourism. Dept The further execution to be done on the behalf of Dept. Social Welfare, Cultural Work, Sport and Tourism.
